I remember very quickly realizing Alta's spirit of servanthood during my final interview with her. As I looked at her work background, some of the jobs that she had held, and the office skills that she possessed, I told her that we could not pay her what she was worth. I'll never forget her reply, "That is okay as long as I can pay for gas and pantyhose, we'll be just fine." She did not view this new job as work to receive a paycheck but as ministry where she could serve the Lord.

I'm thankful that God saw her through her first battle with colon cancer several years ago. But as she so often feared the ugly plague of cancer returned to her body with what seemed like vengeance.

In the beginning of her last fight with cancer she often talked with me about the fear of dying that gave her great concern. We would remind each other of God's promises and course that brought assurance. I saw her fear diminish into faith during our last visits together. In particular, she reminded me of the song, "It Is Well With My Soul," while pointing to her heart and saying, pastor it really is well with my soul.

Alta is certainly going to be missed in our association, but praise be to God that we can say with Paul, "there is *laid up* for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give to me on that Day, and not to me only but also to all who have loved His appearing."

Birdhouses for Annie Armstrong

Children are one of God's greatest blessings. It's so Important to help them grow in faith. Our kids are a top priority at Bethlehem Baptist Church in Crossville. Teaching missions is especially a priority, and our Mission Journey Kids group meets every Sunday evening to learn all about missions. Two years ago, we started a very fun project that affords the kids an opportunity to earn funds to donate to Annie Armstrong. In March 2022, we started our first birdhouse project. What a fun way to get the kids involved in the Annie Armstrong Easter Offering. They were so excited, and you could see the creativity wheels turning as we discussed and planned our first year's project. Several weeks before the Easter offering, we collected old license plates for roofs on the houses. We spent time each week working on the houses. First sanding, next priming, and finally decorating. The kids were very excited and took lots of time uniquely painting and decorating their birdhouse. When finished, the houses were placed on display in the lobby for a silent auction. After a few weeks the winners are announced at our Sunday service and the kids deliver the birdhouse to the winner during the worship service. It is a very fun project and gives the kids an opportunity to participate directly in the mission offering. The 2023 auction earned \$630 dollars for the kids to donate to Annie Armstrong and the 2022 birdhouses earned \$615. The true lesson for our kids is to see that they can serve the Lord now and make a difference now. Some of our other projects we have participated in are Pure Water Pure Love, Lottie Moon tea cookie fundraiser, food drives, and project help. Each of these projects help the kids learn that helping others to see Christ is the most important thing.
