"But when the Pharisees heard that He had silenced the Sadducees, they gathered together. Then one of them, a lawyer, asked Him a question, testing Him, and saying, 'Teacher, which is the great commandment in the law?' Jesus said to him, 'You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself. On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets.'" Matthew 22:34-40

I believe that most of us have survived all that this past month has thrown at us. The weather did shut down almost all our churches for one Sunday. Our offices were closed as icy road conditions kept us in our homes for a couple of days. As usual for our weather pattern we did not have to wait too long before it warmed up and we returned to some semblance of normalcy.

Now February has arrived. We are on to a new month and all that each day will bring. One thing that we expect from this month is found in the word love. Jesus reminds us of the importance of love when asked a simple question. His answer pointed to our love in two areas.

We are to love God with all our being. Do you love God with all your mind? Consider the time you spend each day getting to know and understand God. Do you think about Him? How often do you demonstrate your love for Him through your intellect, with all your mind?

Do you love God with all your soul? Are you enthusiastic about God and what He is passionate about in your life? Do you have an emotional desire to know and serve Him? Let's test it. How do you respond to sin in your life? Is there immediate regret, shame, or guilt? And are you quick to seek His love and forgiveness? How about your soul response in worship? Because you love Him is there a natural response of praise and joy exhibited in your life?

Do you love God with all your heart? When a man and a woman are in love those around them can tell that they constantly think of each other and cannot wait to be together. These two love birds are determined to spend their lives together. The same should be acknowledged in our love relationship with God. Those around us should see that God is the central focus of our lives. Jesus said that the most practical indication of our love for God would be shown in our obedience to Him. Jesus said it, "He who has my commands and keeps them is the one that loves me." John 14:23 Do you love God with all of your being?

Jesus went on to say that we are also to "love your neighbor as yourself." If we absolutely love God, then that love will be exhibited in our love for others. Just like it is stated in I John 4:7-8, "Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God. The one who does not love does not know God, for God is love."

Youth Mental Health First Aid is a 7-hour training for adults who regularly interact with young people ages 12 to 18 – youth ministers/workers, parents, teachers, school staff, etc. This training will introduce common mental health challenges for youth, review typical adolescent development, and teach a 5-step action plan to help young people in both crisis and non-crisis situations. Topics include anxiety, depression, substance use, disorders in which psychosis may occur, disruptive behavior disorders, and eating disorders.


